NEW SCHOOL START AND DISMISSAL TIMES FOR 2016-17 and NEW LUNCH SERVICE TIMES FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS!

North Harrison School District will have new start and dismissal times for the 2016-17 school year. The beginning bell in the junior high and high school will ring at 8:02am. Classes will begin at 8:05am. Classes will dismiss at 3:20pm. Days with "Early Dismissal" we will dismiss at 12:50pm. If we should need a "Late Start" due to weather conditions, we will begin classes at 10:00am. "Late Start" will now just be considered a 10:00am start.

There will be new start times for lunch this year. Elementary students K– 3rd at 11:10am. Jr high students 7th-8th and those students in Vo-Tech will start lunch at 11:31am. Elementary students 4th-6th will go to lunch at 11:51am. Then students in 9th-12th will go to lunch at 12:24.

BUS ROUTES

If you are new to our school district or have relocated, please call our office to ensure pick-up. Families within one mile of the school building must pay \$30 for the first students and \$15 for each additional student in the household, for bus service. In addition the board allows elementary children in 3rd grade and below to ride free of charge if they must cross one of our major highways (Highway N and/or Highway 69) to get to school. Payment is expected at the time of approval. Approval will be granted only if there is space available.

Career Center Students

North Harrison students will attend North Central Career Center in Bethany during the afternoon session. The bus will leave NH at approximately 11:40am.; loading and unloading at the south entrance of the school building. It is anticipated that the bus will return to Eagleville at approximately 2:30pm.

The first day for students to attend classes at NCCC will be Monday, August 22.

NH students MAY or may NOT attend classes at NCCC on days NH has early dismissals; this is their option.

Dual Credit Courses Offered to Qualifying NH Students

NH students can get a jump on their college education earning college credit while enrolled in our high school classes. Students must meet the qualifications outlined by the sponsoring college.

The student is responsible for payment of \$50 per credit hour (\$150 per 3 hour course, per semester). The North Harrison School District will cover the remaining cost. The fee is due with the Dual Credit Enrollment Form on or before August 4th and is payable by post-dated checks to North Harrison School District, which will be receipted on the day indicated. Those not presenting payment may still enroll in the course; however, the work will be for high school credit only.

Courses offered as Dual Credit Classes this school year include College Algebra and College Trigonometry taught by Mr. Mecca, College English taught by Mrs. Rivera, Government and American History taught by Mrs. Percell, and Biology proctored by Mr. Hall. Online Dual Credit Classes can be selected on an individual bases. Cooperating institutions include North Central Missouri College in Trenton, Truman State University in Kirksville, and Missouri Western State University in St. Joe.

Student Insurance Coverage

If you should need affordable accidental injury insurance coverage for your student (Pre-K through 12th grade), the school has coverage available through K & K Insurance Group. Coverage is available for as little as \$29 for the entire school year. You must enroll online this year if you are interested in purchasing. Go to www.studentinsurance-kk.com and click the enroll now button. They also offer plan options. A specific plan is offered to those who are playing football. This will cost you a minimum of \$171.00.

The company will notify NH of the plan purchased. Claim forms may be picked up at Hilary Castleberry's office as needed. A packet is needed for each child and will be distributed with each students Demographic forms or you may pick one up at one of our offices. You may purchase coverage at any time during the school year! A student MUST have proof of insurance for try-outs, practice, or participation in cheerleading, basketball, softball, track or MARCHING BAND!

Unless notified to the contrary in writing within the ten (10) school day period, the school district may disclose any of those items designated as "Directory Information" without the parent's or eligible student's prior written consent including in print and electronic publications of the school district. The final day to give North Harrison School District written notification will be Tuesday, August 30, 2016. Parents may also indicate by this deadline that they do NOT give permission for their student to participate in anonymous surveys required by Safe & Drug-Free Schools and Communities.

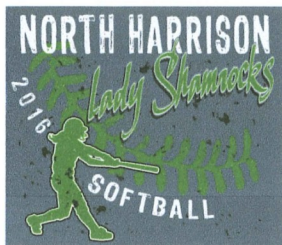
