

Choosing a Colony 3-4

- 1) Read section 3-4
- 2) Choose a colony you would have preferred to live in had you been a settler to the Southern colonies

In a paragraph explain your choice

- discuss the ways in which to make a living
- government
- what makes that particular colony interesting to you

(prepare to give a short presentation over your colony in front of the class)

- 3) create a web diagram summarizing the section
 - the center oval should be labeled Southern Colonies
 - surrounding ovals should be *Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia*
 - surrounding each colony students should note: who created, why, and type of charter – royal, proprietary, corporate

- 4) roundtable on whether the Maryland law mentioned on page 87 was a good idea

5) students will research the health effects of tobacco: deaths or disease from its use, and economic effects of its users

- then the groups must decide whether Southern colonies would have grown tobacco had they been able to see into the future

- rows will create charts (of their choice) that include both health and economic effects of tobacco
- based on that information students will round table and discuss the use of tobacco in America
