A.) Describe the role the French navy had in the ultimate American victory at Yorktown.

B.) Why did Washington change his initial plans from an attack on the British at New York to attacking Cornwallis at Yorktown?

C.) Read both Cornwallis's Defeat on page 185 and Why the Americans Won on page 187. Pretend you are a soldier in the Continental Army and write a journal entry in which you outline why your army was victorious and how you were able to defeat the strongest army and navy on the planet.

Explain why the end of the Revolution meant a “world turned upside-down” for the British.
