NH SCORED LOWER IN 2008 THAN IN 2007 ON ALL MAP AREAS MEASURED FOR APR/AYP. OVERALL IMPROVEMENT SLOWED, BUT 2007 WAS A HUGE JUMP IN PROGRESS FOR THE DISTRICT.

COMPARING NH AVERAGE MAP INDEX SCORES TO THE AVERAGE STATE INDEX SCORES, OVER THE PAST 3 YEARS NH SCORED HIGHER THAN THE STATE IN 31/45 CATEGORIES. THE ONLY CATEGORY THAT WAS NEVER HIGHER WAS 11^{TH GRADE CA.} TWO CATEGORIES (3RD GRADE CA AND 3RD GRADE MATH) EXCEEDED THE STATE AVERAGE INDEX IN ONLY 1 OF 3 YEARS. NH'S CSIP (COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN) AND TECHNOLOGY PLAN GOALS REQUIRE PERCENTAGE INCREASES IN THE TOP TWO CATEGORIES (PROFICIENT AND ADVANCED) OF THE MAP TESTS. OVER THE PAST 3 YEARS, NH HAS SURPASSED THE STATE PERCENTAGES IN 32/45 CATEGORIES. FOR 3RD GRADE MATH, NH SCORED LOWER THAN THE STATE PERCENTAGE FOR 2 OF 3 YEARS. IN CA, THE 11TH GRADE SCORED 16.7% BELOW THE STATE. THIRD GRADE CA SCORED 13.5% BELOW THE STATE FOR THE PAST 2 YEARS.

THE DISTRICT'S EMINTS GOAL OF A 5% INCREASE IN THE TOP TWO LEVELS OF MAP WAS ACHIEVED AT THE END OF THE 2007-08 SCHOOL YEAR FOR 7TH GRADE CA STUDENTS AND IN THE SUB-GROUPS OF 7TH AND 11TH GRADE FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH, AND 7TH GRADE FEMALE AND 11TH GRADE MALE, AND 3RD GRADE IEP STUDENTS.
