- A** Avoid interacting with strangers online.
- B** Beware of cybercriminals. They lure you in with enticing offers. Don't take their bait!
- C** Create strong passwords. Don't use words, dates or phrases that are easily guessed.
- D** Don't share passwords. This creates a security risk and can lead to identity theft.
- E** Exercise caution when browsing online.
- F** Fend off hackers with end-point protection such as anti-virus or anti-malware software.
- G** Get your cybersecurity hat on! The Internet can be a great resource when used properly.
- H** Hackers know no boundaries and are constantly looking for their next target. Be diligent.
- I** Identity theft is real. You are never too old or too young to have your identity stolen.
- J** Join online groups or websites cautiously. Have you vetted the site you are about to join?
- K** Keep all personal information safe. Never share personal information with anyone.
- L** Logout of the computer or accounts you have accessed when you are finished.
- M** Multi-factor authentication helps you double-down on account security and keeps you safe.
- N** Never open an attachment from a sender you do not know or trust.
- O** Only open attachments you know are from a trusted source.
- P** Pause before opening an email from someone you do not know. Ask an adult if it is okay.
- Q** Question emails or websites that look suspicious.
- R** Report any mean, hurtful or phishing emails to a teacher, school administrator or parent.
- S** Seek parent or teacher approval before downloading software or images.
- T** Type web addresses or URLs correctly. Misspellings can lead to visiting unsafe sites.
- U** Understand that when a message or image is posted, uploaded or emailed, it is on the Internet **FOREVER**. Although the message or image might be funny to you, ask yourself, "Is this hurtful or harmful to someone?" If it is, stop.
- V** Visit only websites you know are safe and approved by your parents or teachers, otherwise you might download a virus.
- W** Webcams are instrumental and important tools for remote learning. Review webcam etiquette so sessions are safe, productive and respectful to others.
- X** X factor: free downloads provide the hidden possibility of downloading malware.
- Y** Yesterday is gone forever. However, on the Internet, and through screen shots, that image, post or email **will last FOREVER**.
- Z** Zeroing in on cybersecurity allows you to have a fun and productive learning experience.
